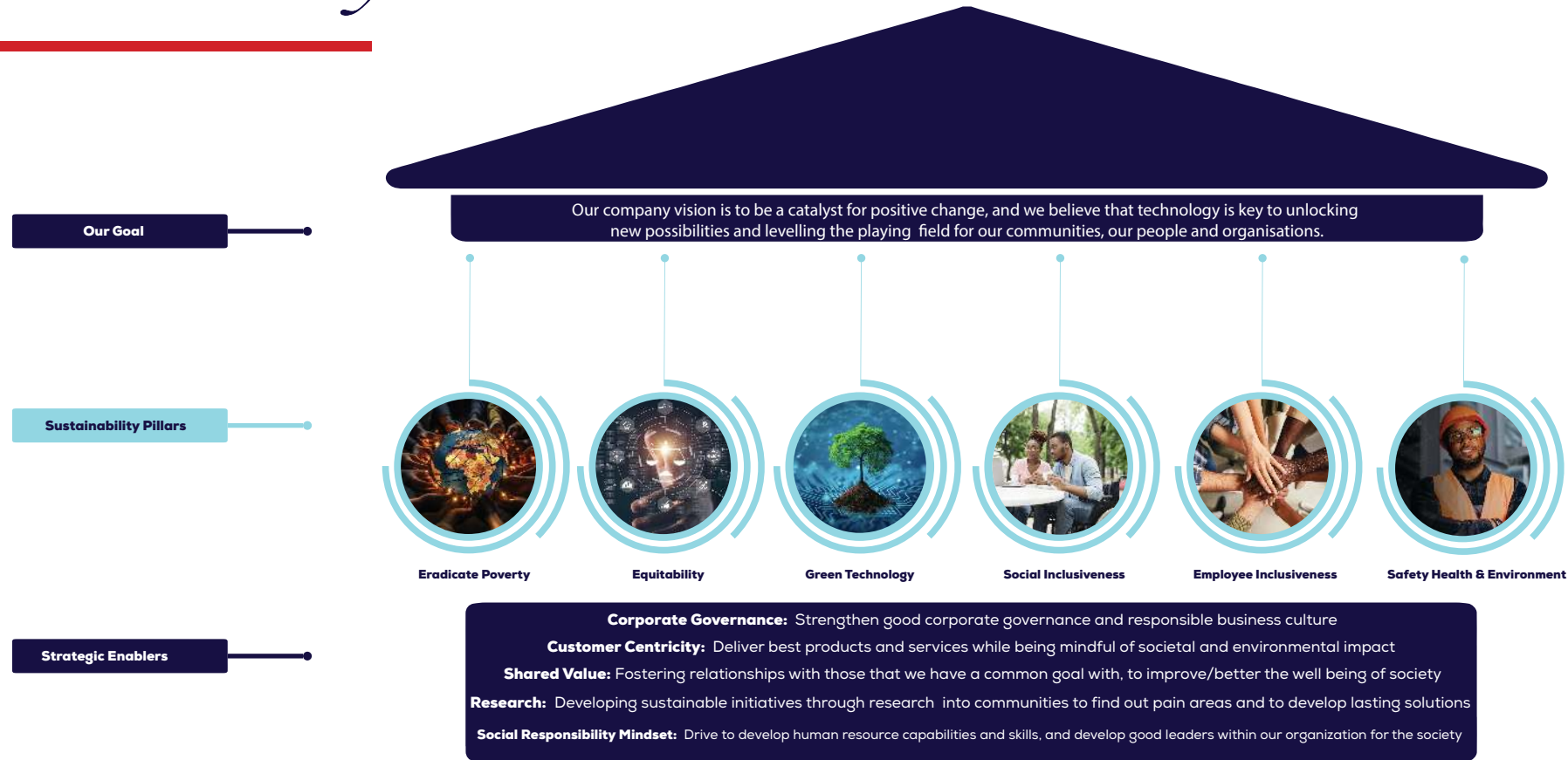

Abaricom remains committed to Equitability as it provides the impetus for diversification of the economy and adds tremendous value.



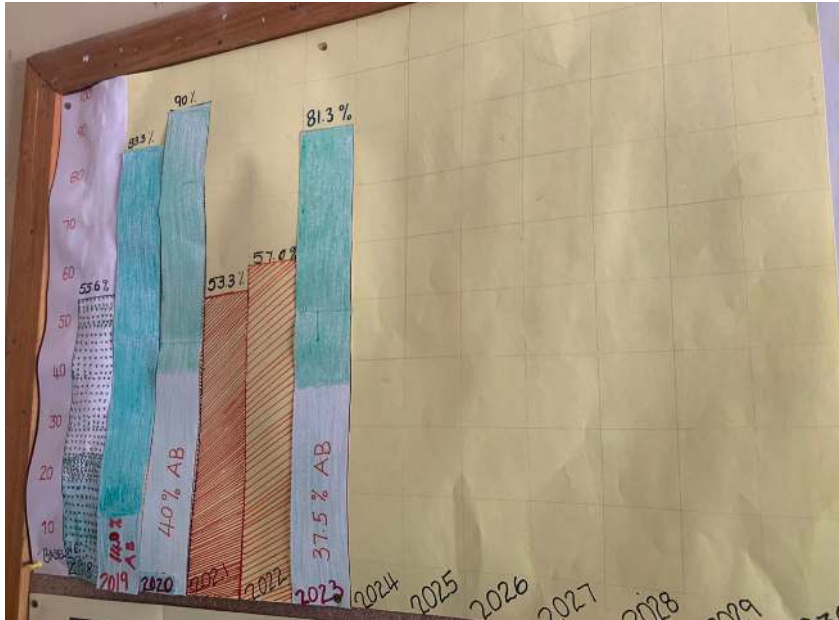

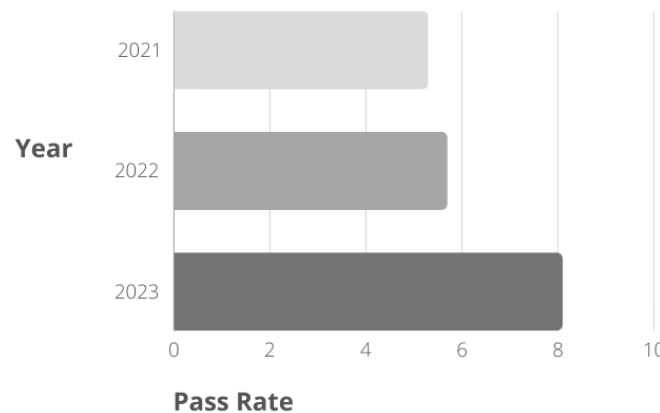
Impacting Communities



Komana Primary School

Komana is a village located in the North-West District of Botswana. Through Abari's partnership with Debswana Information Management department. The initiative was to address challenges facing the school, namely, computer lab network repairs and maintenance, and computer lab Wi-Fi coverage amongst others. Similarly, the school has noticed drastic improvements in their academic performance.

Internet has enabled better learning and ease of research by teachers to enable better learning. The school noted that they had a pass rate of 81 %.



Boteti Region School Connectivity (Ongoing)

The Boteti region connectivity involves primary schools in thirteen villages. This project seeks to deploy internet to the marginalised areas, to ensure that no one gets left behind. The project was done in partnership with one of our strategic partners through the shared value approach of our framework, which seeks to partner with those we have a common goal with to impact lives. Through this project we ensure that Botswana gravitates towards a knowledge-based economy.

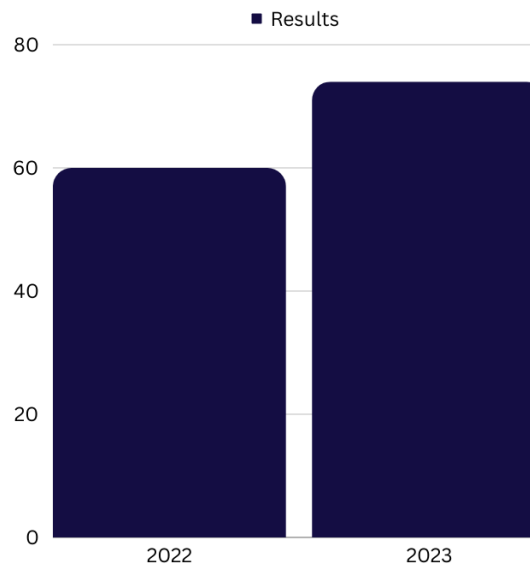
Motswedi Rehabilitation Center & Pudulogong Center For The Blind

One of our goals focuses on social inclusion and therefore seeks to improve the ability, opportunity and dignity of those disadvantaged based on their identity. In a society where the differently abled in our communities are left behind, this initiative intends to remove barriers to create an inclusive and accessible society for all. The two projects are testament to our social inclusion pillar, ensuring that even with their disabilities, they are not left behind. And so, Abari prides itself in giving the marginalised accessibility to resources.

Impacting Communities

Chanoga Primary School Connectivity

Chanoga, situated in the South- Eastern part of Maun has become a thriving tourism destination. The village, however, faces socio-economic problems such as high rate of unemployment and extreme poverty. For this reason, it was key to improve the quality and livelihoods of the inhabitants through technology, thereby bridging the digital divide gap. Internet connectivity will enable early-stage educational development for the school as well as the community, and further enable innovativeness. This project re-affirms our position as a business of being an enabler of digitalization in the country.



This was also to enable innovativeness and connectivity in the village as a whole.

In partnership with JCI Oldies Chapter , we provided internet to Chanoga Primary School. The purpose of this was to enable early-stage educational development for the community of Chanoga. Through continuous monitoring and evaluation we get to realise the impact made in the school. Overall the school pass rate increased from 60% in 2022 to 74% in 2023. To assess this impact, an actual value was measured against a baseline value. It is evident that connectivity has greatly impacted academic performance, such as improving knowledge in ICT, enhancing the learners general knowledge as well as the teachers, and enable their access to academic information.

Impacting Communities

Makalamabedi Jss

Makalamabedi Junior Secondary School has been one of our beneficiaries. Through investing in education of children in rural areas, we believe we are bettering and impacting lives. Therefore connecting schools has been one of our key projects, enabling us to touch lives and make a difference. As we continually monitor and evaluate our projects we are able to see the impact we are making.

Connecting schools allows children to develop skills and access online learning content.



Maun & Mohembo Kgotla

As part of our quest to include every Motswana in the digital economy, Abari has provided internet to remote areas such as in Mohembo and Maun Kgotla's. This is part of the digital inclusivity strategy and bridging the digital divide gap. In marginalised areas, Kgotlas serve as a vital hub for delivery essential social services such as sending letters, job applications and accessing other services. With government's digitalization agenda, most services can be accessed on the 1Gov e-services portal. Additionally, with farming being the main economic activity in rural areas, community members rely on systems such as the BAITS system in which they upload information on their livestock.

Therefore, through internet connectivity the public can easily access these services without having to travel long distances to the nearest town, or village to access them.

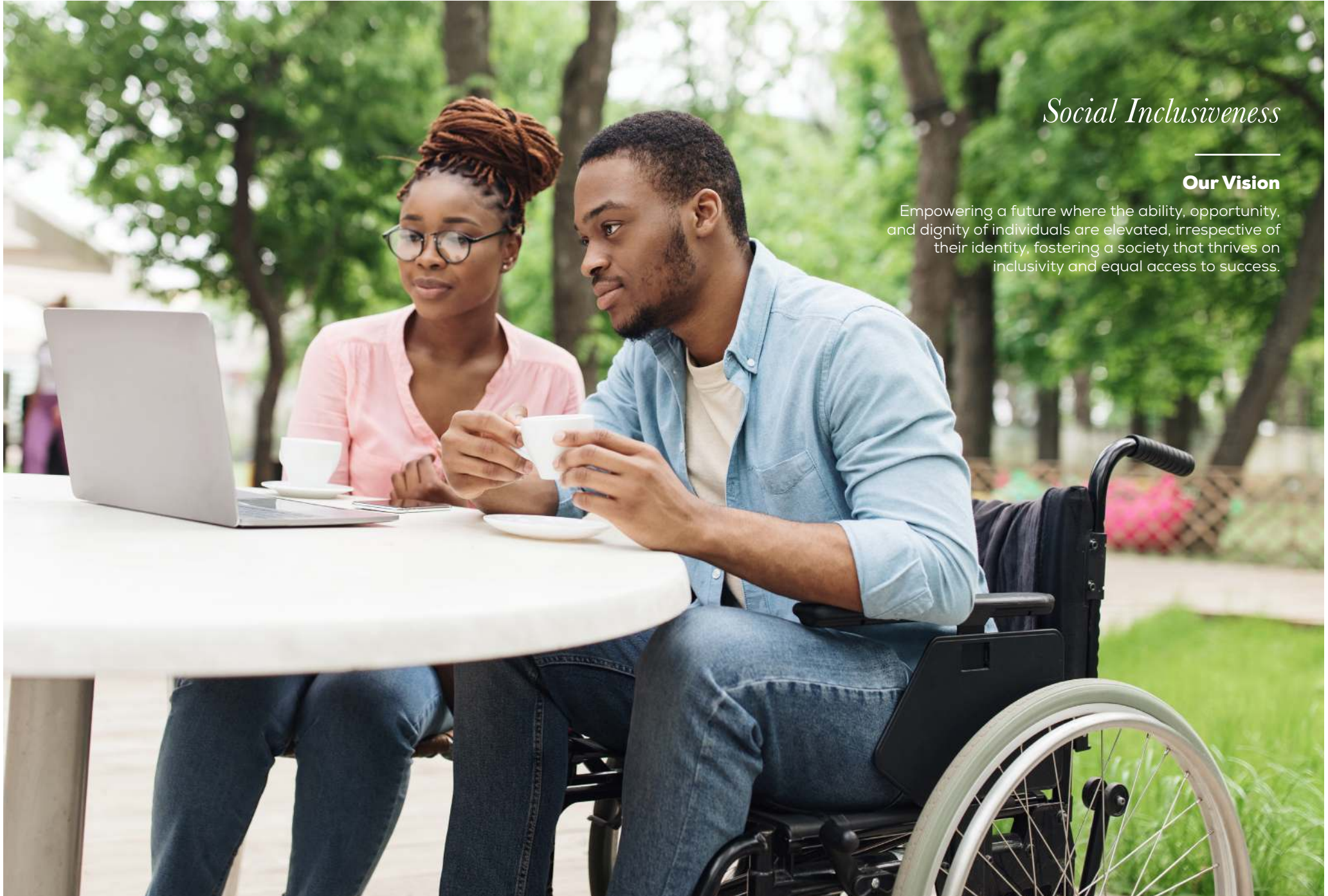

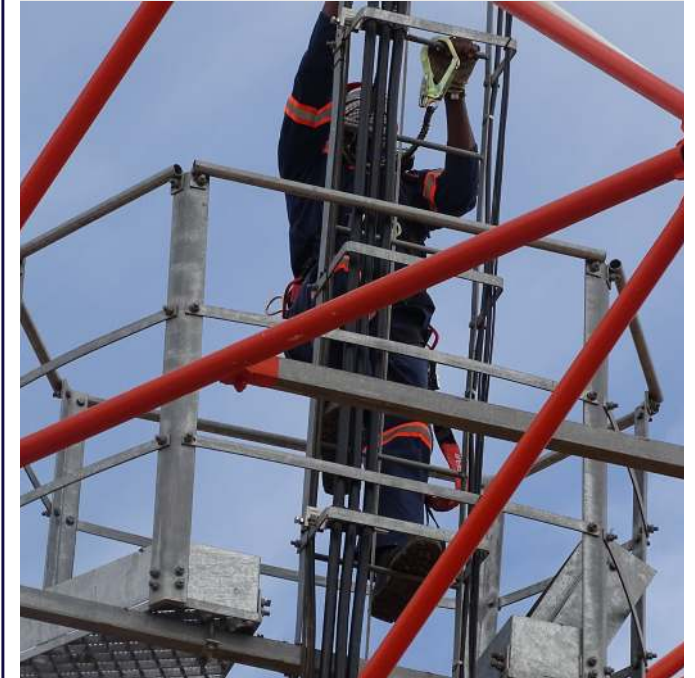
